The European Training Model, will contain the description of :

- pedagogical principles
- training goals (resulting from O1 and O2 -list of competence)
- learning outputs (resulting from O3, survey report which is coming)
- training content (a guide for O5- curriculum);
- training pathways and methodology : blended learning, online learning (MOOC- O8) and face to face training (workshops - O11)
- training/learning methods and tools (as guide for O6)
- assessment and evaluation methodology (as guide for O7)

Output no. 5 Training Curriculum

The participants worked in two groups on the list of the topics. Then, they presented the results of their work and proposed changes in the list of the topics. The partners established that the curriculum to have 3 Modules: Create your business, Getting started and In the market .

Output no. 6 Training/ learning/assessment resources

Partners will collect learning/evaluation materials in CC license or develop content themselves, and other materials relating to the proposed modules and topics, such as text, files, audio, video, quiz, recommended links etc. in order to aid the development of learning activities for the curriculum and educational tools for training.
