- To design the plan of the Intellectual Output no. 5

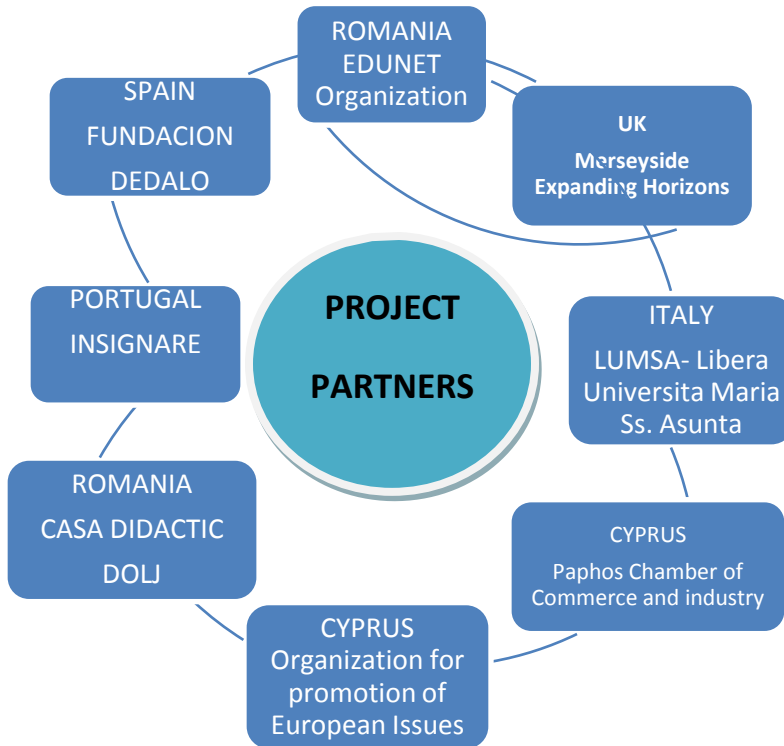


The Meeting Results were:
